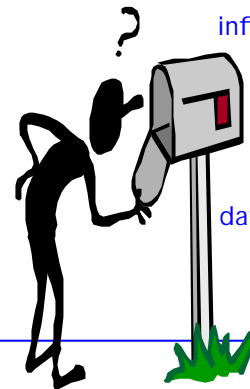

to the area. He will be doing various odd jobs around the grounds including painting the Clubhouse, gardening and repairs.

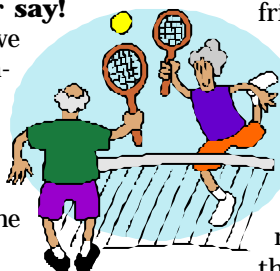


Dates for Your Diary
